Case: Washington Medical Commission Complaint - Anjali D'Souza, MA, LMHCA, MHP

Document Type: CPS Closure Analysis

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Summary

Analysis of CPS/DCYF case closure patterns demonstrating rapid closure without investigation, supporting allegations of false reporting based on unverified information from therapy sessions.

Key Findings

1. **Rapid Closure Pattern:** CPS cases closed without interviewing Kit despite joint custody
2. **No Investigation Conducted:** Cases marked as unfounded without proper investigation
3. **Pattern of False Reports:** Multiple reports coinciding with court hearings
4. **Failure to Interview Parent:** Despite joint legal custody and decision-making rights

Professional Impact

These closure patterns support the WMC complaint allegations that Ms. D'Souza filed CPS reports based on unverified information, contributing to weaponization of protective services during custody proceedings.
