Key Provisions:

Joint Legal Custody Confirmed: - Both parents maintain joint legal custody and decision-making authority - Medical and mental health treatment requires joint consent - No unilateral decision-making permitted regarding children's healthcare

Contact Rights Established: - Court orders establishing Veronika's right to contact with children - Violation of contact provisions constitutes contempt of court - Parenting plan provisions are legally binding on both parties
