

Dear Family Law Staff,

I respectfully object to the opposing party's request to strike today's hearing in Goodnight v. Ralidak ([20-3-03830-3](#) SEA).

This is now the third time the Respondent and his counsel have failed to appear or have sought to strike hearings hours before they are scheduled. These repeated last-minute tactics amount to litigation abuse and are causing severe prejudice to me and my children.

I have now been separated from my children for 143 days, despite:

- No criminal charges against me,
- Every CPS investigation being closed with no findings,
- Multiple professionals (Dr. Oreskovich, Dr. Bowker, and GAL Jolly) supporting my custody, and
- Prior judicial findings (Judge Ponomarchuk and Judge Rampersad) recognizing me as the children's primary caregiver and decision-maker.

Further delay compounds the harm. Contact orders are being ignored, and my children remain confused and distressed by this ongoing separation. The Court has already found that they should not be away from me for more than a week, yet we are now approaching five months.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that today's hearing proceed as scheduled and that the Court deny Respondent's request to strike and renote. Allowing another delay without consequence will further undermine the Court's own prior findings, due process, and my fundamental rights as a

parent.
