



**II. Petitioner Veronika Goodnight's violations of our 6/25/24 Parenting Plan.**

**Section 5. Decision Making.** Healthcare is a joint decision except for the carveout provisions on pages 9-10.

On 10/14/24, I was notified that Veronika pulled the children out of school early for an appointment with a therapist. The choice of therapist and the children's appointments were not discussed with me. When asked, Veronika refused to provide me with information on the therapist. *See Ex. A.*

On 4/25/25, Veronika unilaterally cancelled all three children's therapy appointments without my permission. *See true & correct copy of the email attached as Ex. B.* The children have all been in therapy since April 2024 and October 2024 respectively. I was able to provide documentation for the therapists, and they agreed it was proper and in the children's best interest to continue. *Id.*

**Section 10 – Other occasion important to the family (page 6).** The Court specifically stated: The Court... clarifies that the children should not be pulled out of school for birthday celebrations. On 3/21/25, Veronika took all three children out of school for EGR's birthday. *See school attendance record attached as Ex. C.*

**Section 14 Co-Parenting App.** The parenting plan states, "The parents must use TalkingParents...for all communications regarding the children." On 4/4/24, Veronika approached my vehicle as I was waiting in line at parent pickup and started interrogating me about her living arrangements (her plan to live in an RV with the children without running water or electricity). A school official called CPS out of concern for the children, but Veronika thought I called CPS and confronted me in-person at the school.

**Section 14. Decision-Making Healthcare Provisions (page 9).** I have sole authority to have the children vaccinated. On 4/15/25, Veronika cancelled the vaccination appointments I made for all three children for 7/23/25 without telling me. *See Ex. D.* I scheduled the appointments four months in advance.

I also have sole authority to select a doctor/pediatrician for the children to see for annual exams and pursue any course of action recommended by the pediatrician. I scheduled an appointment for 5/7 to follow up on our oldest child's stomach issues as

recommended by the pediatrician. When I went to reschedule the appointment for 5/22, it was immediately cancelled. Upon inquiry, it was Veronika who cancelled it as she is the only other person who has access to the children's MyChart account. See *Ex. E*. She consistently sabotages my efforts to obtain medical care and services for the children as she believes the children's care should only be provided by her naturopath. Veronika's cancelling of the appointments I am authorized to schedule is in violation of our parenting plan.

During one visit, the pediatrician recommended allergy testing for ER. This recommendation gave me the authority to choose and schedule an appointment with an allergist but when Veronika saw the recommendation on MyChart, she scheduled an appointment with Northwest Allergy without consulting or notifying me. NW Allergy called me to confirm the appointment because they saw in the notes I needed to be informed of the appointment. They decided to cancel the appointment until they could review the parenting plan. Veronika does not have the authority to unilaterally chose medical providers for the children.

#### **Section 14. Child's Involvement and Derogatory Comments.**

A series of recent events has caused me further concern for the safety of the children, even during their phone calls, and Veronika's mental well-being. She has repeatedly violated the terms in our parenting plan which prohibit involving the children in legal issues and discussions about parenting schedule. She has also repeatedly violated the term which prohibits her from making derogatory comments about the other parent (me).

#### **III. Veronika's Escalating Behavior.**

Since the DVPO was put in place on 4/11/25, Veronika has demonstrated an increase in threatening and manipulative behavior that causes concern for her mental health. See summary below.

“You need to tell your therapist the truth, okay? No more lying, okay? No more lying. [she was talking to RSR]

**P. 40.** [talking to AR] “I need you to tell your therapist how much you miss us together, okay?”

**P. 41.** “Can you tell everybody, you know, that you want to be with me on your birthday?”

7/24/25 Involving the Children in Legal Matters. Ex. J

ER on call with Veronika. Veronika puts Therese Henning, a stranger to the children, on the phone who talks about a movie she's making where Veronika is going to be one of her stars, that she hasn't seen her son for three years, and Veronika is a voice for kids that don't have a voice right now.

7/31/25 Involving the Children in Legal Matters. Ex. K

ER was cornered at church VBS by a friend of Veronika's who showed her some text messages. The messages were from Veronika who shared information about the movie she was making and an ad for the candlelight vigil she planned. ER was so upset by this that she asked us to call the police. We were issued case **#C25023160**.

8/3/25 Derogatory Comments and Sharing Case Details on Social Media. Ex. L

Veronika posted on Facebook, details about our case and stated: All “orders” from incompetent jurisdiction are void...”

8/3/25 Derogatory Comments

Someone from church notified Monica about the podcast and vigil and Facebook posts Veronika is saying about us because she feels things are unsafe.

Between 4/25/25 to 6/3/25, TalkingParents (TP) transcripts show Veronika repeatedly asking the children to testify on her behalf at least eight times. Making statements such as: “tell anyone who will listen, teachers, principal, and counselors, about our love, how good our family is, what a good mom I am” and other sentiments. See one example below and Exhibit Q.

00:04:21 - Veronika Goodnight - Do you believe I'm a good mom. You're a good kid. I need you to tell whoever will listen how much you love me and miss me. I need you to remember our good life, okay? That will bring us together. All right? And if I. If we don't talk, it's because I'm working and I have no way to call you back. Okay? And I think of you every second of every day, and I just. I miss you. You need to tell everyone who will listen what a good mom I am and how much you miss me and how much you want to be back together. And that's when we'll get back together. Okay? Okay. And keep praying. I keep praying. Every day I give it up to God, and God is going to make us together again. Okay?

Veronika is involving the children in legal matters and asking them to speak out on her behalf regarding the residential schedule in violation of the parenting plan.

On July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024, Veronika used the children’s phone to send me a derogatory message about my parenting and included details about the Judge’s ruling. She violated the provisions prohibiting involving the children and making derogatory comments about the other parent. See *Ex. R*.

**Current Protection/Restraining Order.** I have a DVPO against Veronika under King County Case #25-2-11308-6 SEA. The DVPO expires on the date of our Adequate Cause and Motion for Temporary Family Law Order hearing, 8/25/25. *Sub #64.*

Although enforcement would properly be in the protection case, I think it is important for the court to understand, Veronika also does not feel the need to obey the protection order.

In the DVPO order, the court stated, the “Protected Party must file a modification order for the family law court to consider.” *Id.*, p. 10. I scheduled an Adequate Cause Hearing in this case for 6/27/25. The court stated it was not making finding regarding parenting but noted that the “allegations and statements in the therapy notes are extremely concerning.” *Id.* A copy of the petition for DVPO, therapy notes, and CPS records are filed with this motion under seal.

Since the protection order was granted on 4/11/25, Veronika has violated it at least six times, resulting in cases listed in the chart below.

5/10	Contacted police after Veronika called my phone on 5/8 in violation of the DVPO. The police determined her violation was: 1 direct phone call. <b>Police Case #C25014244</b>
5/14	Contacted police after Veronika called and sent messages to my secondary phone for the children in violation of the DVPO. The police determined her violation was: 3 direct messages and facetime attempt to a phone I own. <b>Police Case #C25014695</b>
5/15	Veronika unilaterally cancelled Elora’s therapy appointments. <i>See true &amp; correct copy of the email attached as Ex. A.</i> Contacted police after Veronika sent me a direct message through Talking Parents app in violation of the DVPO. The police determined her violation was: 1 direct message to my phone. <b>Police Case #C25014822</b>
6/4	Veronika joined, without registering or paying, for a parenting class I signed up for 7 months ago. She accessed my logon information through our son’s medical records on MyChart. Violation of 3 <sup>rd</sup> party contact. <b>Police case #C25017058</b>
6/6	Contacted police after Veronika sent a direct messages to my phone via Talking Parents in violation of the DVPO. The police determined her violation was: 1 direct message to my phone. <b>Police Case #C25017335</b>

However, you acted against the parenting plan by scheduling an appointment for our children and failing to inform me or provide the doctor with the final order, which contains clear instructions on any vaccines to be administered. You also scheduled appointments for evaluations without consulting me or coordinating with my schedule- also contrary to the order. Your actions are creating difficulties for the kids, and I will not continue to engage in this behavior.

Dear Anjali and Dawson Place Staff supervisor,

I am writing to formally notify you that I am withdrawing my consent for any continued therapy services for my daughter, Elora Luna Goodnight-Ralidak (DOB: 03/21/2015), until pending family law proceedings regarding custody, medical decision-making, and access rights are resolved in King County Superior Court.

As a parent with legal joint decision-making authority over Elora's healthcare, I have serious concerns about the current therapeutic environment and the use of therapy records in a manner that has caused significant harm to me and to Elora's continuity of care. Specifically:

- I have been denied any involvement or coordination in Elora's care for over 42 days, in violation of existing court orders.
- I was not consulted about her ongoing participation in sessions or the release of confidential therapeutic notes.
- I have learned that the therapy notes were used against me out of context in a protection order matter initiated under false pretenses.
- Most alarmingly, Elora is reportedly still being taken to the same church where her perpetrator was present — an environment I had previously flagged as unsafe and inappropriate for her healing.

In light of these unresolved legal concerns, I request that all therapy appointments be paused immediately. Please confirm in writing that services have been suspended and that no further sessions or reports will occur without my express consent.

I appreciate the work Dawson Place does in our community and hope this pause can help protect both Elora's mental health and her right to meaningful parental support.

Mathew Ralidak and Veronika Goodnight:

As E [REDACTED] is treating therapist and her therapist's supervisor, we are writing this letter after reviewing the current domestic violence protection order, family parenting plan, and supplemental findings. It appears that, despite the protection order that is in place, E [REDACTED] mother still has joint medical decision-making rights for E [REDACTED]. We temporarily suspended E [REDACTED] therapeutic treatment per her mother's request while we researched this issue.

It should also be noted that therapeutic records were released based on Elora's father's request to release them, which was in compliance with Washington State law.

After consulting with the Quality Department at Compass Health, we received the following response: It is consistent with Compass Health values/previous decision making, and with state laws that we continue to treat E [REDACTED]. Per the Washington state health law manual, "If a health care provider has notice, however, that the parents are in conflict regarding either the terms of the parenting plan or divorce decree, or the giving of consent to specific health care, the provider should obtain a copy of the parenting plan or divorce decree for interpretation. If the authority or custody is deemed to be mutual or joint or not allocated, and the parents continue to be unable to resolve their differences, they should be told to either reach an agreement or to obtain a court order authorizing the treatment or non-treatment. If treatment, such as ongoing counseling sessions or a medication regime or a surgical procedure, has been started at the time of receipt of notice of opposition to it by the other parent, it should be brought to a clinically appropriate conclusion and not interrupted to the detriment of the patient."

Because we believe that disruption in E [REDACTED] therapy will be detrimental to her, we are choosing to continue E [REDACTED] treatment with Compass Health at this time. E [REDACTED] has utilized therapeutic treatment very well thus far. She has benefitted from her time in therapy and has seen a decrease in the following symptoms: episodes of emotional dysregulation, anxious thoughts, and feelings of anger. We expect that E [REDACTED] father will continue to will continue to work to resolve this conflict between E [REDACTED] parents related to her mental health treatment through family court.
