I declare,

1. I am the respondent in this case and the biological mother of the protected person's three children.
2. I am submitting this supplemental declaration to bring to the Courts attention of ongoing violations of our parenting plan and controlling behavior by Mathew Ralidak, which directly relate to the nature of this protection order case.
3. On April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Mathew scheduled a medical appointment for Elora without informing me. I was not told of the change in provider or time. I canceled a day of work and when I arrived early, I was denied entry by the provider since Mathew earlier made false claims that I was an alcoholic, drug addict and had mental illness. He created a scene and my daughter looked coerced so I made another appointment with L. Miller the following week to create peace and I left quietly. The provider L. Miller listed her psychiatric behavior as "nervous/anxious" on 4/10/25 appointment and at the following appointment L. Miller removed the false medical family history. See exhibit B.
4. Following the April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025 medical appointment, where I was denied entry and witnessed my daughter Elora exhibiting signs of distress and coercion, I had a follow-up discussion with Lisa Miller, ARNP. Cassidy Derieg was present with me at this appointment as L. Miller is Cassidy's nurse practitioner as well. Ms. Miller noted that Elora's psychiatric presentation was anxious and nervous, and it became clear that Elora needed a supportive adult presence to feel safe during future appointments. After consultation with Ms. Miller, we mutually agreed that a "Consent to Treat a Minor without

Parent or Guardian Present" form would be signed to allow Cassidy Derieg—Colin Derieg's daughter, and step sister to Elora—to attend the next appointment on May 7<sup>th</sup>. However, Mat rescheduled the appointment for May 22<sup>nd</sup> without informing me, and again failed to coordinate. Cassidy is fearful of Mathew's behavior and radical false accusations and is uncomfortable at appointments without me being present. This protection order is inhibiting our children care they need. This pattern of scheduling without notice and cancelling appointments after I have already communicated with him on TalkingParents further demonstrates Mathew's continued interference with my parental role and the court-ordered joint medical authority. Please see Exhibit C.

5. In addition, I scheduled Elora for allergy testing per L. Miller's recommendation, on August 13<sup>th</sup>, their ONLY available time, during my 2 week uninterrupted summer time. Mathew then contacted NW Allergy and Asthma Center, canceled the appointment without my consent, and demanded to reschedule, falsely accusing me of "contempt". Screenshots are attached as Exhibit D. This demonstrates a repeated pattern of interference and misrepresentation of the court orders.
6. These incidents reflect a continued misuse of authority and legal process to exclude me from our children's medical care and violate our parenting plan. This behavior is not consistent with someone needing protection; it is consistent with someone exerting control and undermining the court's intent for shared parenting. This pattern that undermines the court's intention for cooperative, joint parenting has been aggressive for 5 years.
7. The protection order entered against me stated that Mathew Ralidak was to immediately file a family law motion to resolve the parenting issues raised. He failed to do so. I complied and filed the appropriate family law motions, which Commissioner Marianne Jones acknowledged during the Ex Parte Adequate Cause hearing. My sincere hope is that by following the directive of the protection order and utilizing the proper legal channels, this pattern of aggressive behavior—which has actively undermined the court's intention for cooperative joint parenting for over five years- will finally be addressed and ended. I have taken all steps required of me and ask the Court to recognize that this misuse of the legal process must be stopped. I and especially our children deserve peace.

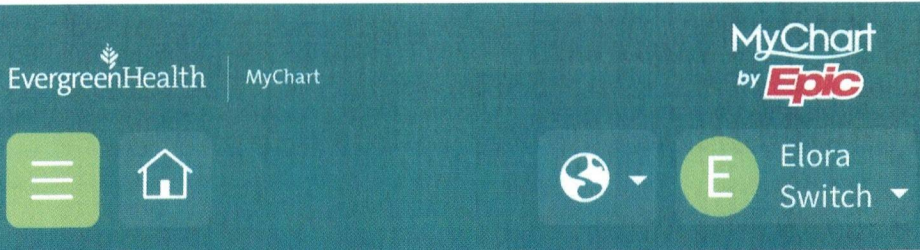

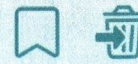
