Instructions from Mark Stein

Aidan is a 8 y.o. male presenting with inattention, academic underachievement, and parental conflict. His father had similar difficulties as a child.

Parents differ markedly in their approach and mother does not feel he has attention problems but does take him to counseling.

Teacher ratings are suggestive of ADHD and perhaps an underlying learning disorder. He is a happy child who has several friends.

DSM-5 DIAGNOSES:

1. R/o ADHD
2. R/o Learning Disorder

Recommendations include:

1. **Parent to request school conduct an evaluation for an IEP, suspicion of a Learning Disorder in Reading and Writing. I am happy to review findings and participate in an IEP meeting.**
2. **Referral to ADHD First Steps for psychoeducation**
3. **Referral to superparenting for behavioral parent training to target noncompliance**
4. **Follow up in 3 months or sooner if there are concerns or questions.**
